



## COVID-19 Health and Safety Wellness Plan

The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has established a set of standard precautions to minimize the risk of spreading infectious diseases. Our ministry will adhere to the following precautions.

### Standard Precautions in Trinity Kids Environments:

- Staff, team members, and children will practice social distancing measures by limiting room capacity to 50% and staying six feet apart from one another using markers placed on floors.
- Due to limited capacity and to allow for contact tracing, pre-registration is highly recommended. Registration will be available one week in advance. Go to [www.trinity-churchvb.com/register](http://www.trinity-churchvb.com/register) to RSVP.
- Facemasks that cover the nose and mouth are required for all staff and team members.
- It is highly recommended that Trinity Kids 4 years and older wear facemasks that cover the nose and mouth.
- Facemasks will be made available to anyone that does not have their own.
- Touchless thermometer temperature checks and a health screening questionnaire will be conducted at check-in for staff, team members, and children before being allowed to enter into environments.
- Parents will be asked to take children for a bathroom break and wash their hands before entering classrooms.
- Prior to every service, a thorough cleaning of our children's environments will be performed using EPA approved cleaning agents and recommended protocols.
- Common use items which cannot be sanitized will be removed from Trinity Kids environments or will be prepared ahead of time to allow for single use without sharing.
- Surfaces and objects that are frequently touched will be routinely cleaned and sanitized after each use of room.
- Trinity Kids' are encouraged to bring their own personal Bibles with them to church.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be readily available. Children and team members will be asked to sanitize hands with alcohol-based sanitizer before entering classrooms.
- Team members and children will be instructed and educated to wave "hi" instead of handshakes, hugs, or fist bumps.



## Wellness Attendance Policy

Our Trinity Kids staff and team members consider the well-being of our children to be a sacred trust. In the best interest of both our children and our team members, we request that individuals with contagious illness or potentially contagious illness- whether they are children or ministry workers – not participate in Trinity Kids.

**Children and team members must be well for a minimum of 24 hours prior to coming to church.**

If any of the following symptoms exist, the child will not participate in Trinity Kids:

- fever (above 100.4 degrees)
- vomiting
- diarrhea
- chronic cough
- skin rash
- unexplained or contagious open rash
- pink eye
- excessive signs of cold, sore throat, runny nose, or sneezing
- any flu-like symptoms

### Onsite Health Screening Process

As an added layer of precaution to keep our families as safe as possible, all household members will be asked to participate in a two-part health Screening.

**Part 1** – Touchless thermometer temperature check

**Part 2** – Health screening questionnaire with the following questions:

Has anyone in your household ...

- Been experiencing flu like symptoms in the last two weeks?
- Had exposure to a person with a known or suspected case of COVID-19?
- Traveled for leisure in the last two weeks?

### Confirmed Outbreak Policy

If a person has a confirmed case of COVID-19 and has been in a Trinity Kids environment, we will take the following steps to ensure the safety and well-being of our families:

- We will temporarily close, following the protocol of Trinity Church guidelines.
- Parents will be notified through proper communication channels that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19.
- Confidentiality of the person with the confirmed case will be maintained in accordance with HIPPA.
